

# VMCC STIRLING CASTLE SECTION

## Ride an Old Bike Event at Culty Braggan, PH6 2HX

**Sunday 17<sup>th</sup> May 2026 - Morning Session arrive by 9.30am Afternoon Session arrive by 1.00pm**

This event is designed to give motorcyclists an opportunity to try riding older and more unusual bikes. **We want to raise interest levels and persuade more people to join the VMCC as well as allowing existing members to ride types of machines that they are not familiar with.** We want to encourage more people to acquire and use older motorcycles. **You must have your current FULL motorcycle licence with you.**

The bikes available for riding will feature flat tankers including v twins. There will be an early Neracar. The John McMillan Sunbeam will be there and many more.

The event will be held at Culty Braggan, the ex-POW camp, on the outskirts of Comrie. Bikes will be ridden around a 0.3 mile circuit. Participants will complete three laps on each of the machines they have paid to ride. Initially you can pay to ride up to three machines but it is likely that further machines can be tried on the day, if time permits. Cost per additional bike is £5.

There will be a caterer supplying refreshments and lunch, at participants own expense. There are toilets on site. For the morning session, **signing in will be from 9.30am until 10.00am.** At 10.00 am there will be an **Introduction and Safety Briefing.** For the afternoon session, **signing in will be from 1.00am until 1.30pm.** At 1.30 pm there will be an **Introduction and Safety Briefing.**

Riding in the morning will be 10.30am until 1.00pm. Riding in the afternoon will be 2.00pm until 4.30pm

All participants must **complete the form overleaf and email it (paying their fees at the same time (or within seven days if sending by post)).** Registration is £30/rider plus £5/bike ridden. Non VMCC members must also pay £5 for a day membership so they are covered under the club's insurance scheme. (NB no money goes to owners for use of bikes, only for transporting the bikes to Culty Braggan so this is NOT a hire arrangement. The rest of the money will cover high viz jackets, printing etc)
